## How it works

Children are split into groups according to their ages and year groups, with each group then rotating the different sessions. This ensures that each session is tailored to the ages and needs of the group.

### Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> May

#### Ali Sparkes' Scribe Tribe

Masterclasses for young writers led by Ali, an award-winning author of over 40 books including the Shapeshifter series and Frozen in Time, Scribe Tribe looks at a range of techniques including characterisation, dialogue, plot, pace, editing and research.

#### Martin Maudsley

A lively and interactive storytelling session in the woods using poetry, music and songs, with professional storyteller Martin, who is the patron of the Somerset Storytelling Festival. (Years 1 – 6 only)

#### Tabatha Palmer

A creative workshop on a literary theme, run by Perrott Hill's Head of Art, with the finished pieces ready to take home at the end of the day. This workshop is aimed specifically at senior pupils. (Years 7 and 8 only)

#### The Somerset Youth Theatre

A drama workshop showing children how to bring stories to life, from Nick White of the Wassail Theatre Company and on behalf of the new Somerset Youth Theatre.

#### Tamsin Cooke

An imaginative session focusing on creating fabulous heroes and terrifying villains, from the author of The Scarlet Files and Stunt Double.

#### Cliff McNish

The five easy steps to creating a good story, by award-winning author Cliff – who is described by The Times as 'one of our most talented thriller writers'. His first set of novels, The Doomspell Trilogy, is published in 26 languages worldwide.
